County Awards Grant to Enhance Kitchen

Great News!! Delaware County Commissioners awarded BWAHS a grant in the amount of \$2874.67 as part of the 2018 Community Enhancement Grant Funds. The Commissioners, who oversee this fund, awarded the funds to be used for the purchase and installation of a dishwasher in the kitchen at the Myers Inn and flooring for the adjacent storage room. BWAHS Board of Trustees approved the project in March with an anticipated completion date in late summer or early fall 2018.

The addition of the dishwasher will greatly streamline the cleanup after the many luncheons and dinners held at the Myers Inn and help the sanitization requirements by the Delaware County Board of Health. The grant will cover 90% of the cost of the project. A donor has come forward to cover the additional 10% cost.
