B.W.A.H.S. Received Grant For Myers Inn Maintenance

Del-Co Water Community Fund of the Delaware County Foundation awarded Big Walnut Area Historical Society \$500 towards the painting of the Myers Inn.

Maintaining a 200 year old structure is not easy or cheap. Last winter when the Trustees hired Integrity Painting to prepare and paint the exterior of the Myers Inn, we agreed to apply for a grant to assist with the cost so we could replace the money in our savings for future expansion. We applied to the Delaware County Foundation in August.

Although we were in the painter's que, it was August before they could start and then we were visited by rain so often, the task was not finished

As a non-profit organization, we feel blessed to be able to share our local history with you. A variety of programs are presented each month on facets of history. Special events such as the 5 Open Houses throughout the year give us the opportunity to share our heritage.

On January 5 we had our first wedding in Myers Inn.

We were awarded a joint Delaware Community Foundation Grant with Community Library to secure funding for Lenny Lepola to transfer his photos to archival files for us and the library. Plus the recent grant towards painting the Myers Inn.

BWAHS sponsored a trip to the National Veterans Museum and to the Portsmouth Flood Wall Mural.

We did programs for 37 sixth graders, 205 high school American history students, and both a school visit and museum visit for 283 third graders.

BWAHS worked with Community Library to read historic books to children in the library.

We sponsored Valentine luncheon, a Mother's Day Tea, and co-sponsored Sunbury Fall Heritage Day where June Campbell became our Honoree.
